Rebates up to \$4,000 are available based on the total energy savings achieved in your home from recommended measures. Plus, you may be eligible for **NJNG financing up to \$15,000**, including a \$10,000 0% APR option.*

HPwES Rebate Level	Requirements
\$2,000 rebate**	Estimated total energy savings between five and 19 percent
\$3,000 rebate**	Estimated total energy savings between 20 and 24 percent
\$4,000 rebate**	Estimated total energy savings of 25 percent or more
